Club show regulations :

The show is organized according to the reglements of FCI and ČMKU and the regulations issued by the organizer.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Only the dogs with the FCI recognized pedigree may be shown. Sick, cropped and docked dogs can not take part at the show. The exhibitor is liable for any damages caused by his/her dog(s) at the show. The exhibitor is liable for the presentation of his/her dog(s) by the catalogue numbers in the ring in due time. With signing the registration form, exhibitors accept to conform to the Czech Kennel Club Bylaws on Exhibiting. The organizer reserves the right to substitute the judges. The organizer reserves the right not to accept the entry form for the show.

VETERINARY REGULATIONS :

All the entered dogs must be clinically healthy. Dogs must have PET PASSPORT with valid vaccination against rabies and must meet the conditions by the EU Regulation 998/2003 from 26/5/2003

Classes on the Club show:

- minor puppy class 4 – 6 months
- puppy class 6 - 9 months
- junior class 9 - 18 months
- intermediate class 15 - 24 months
- Winter class from 15 months - must be accompanied by a photocopy of the diploma C.I.B, Championship , National winner, Club winner, Winner of special show, European winner, World winner
- honor class from 15 months – for dogs with titles International champion, Champion, National and Club winner (Title certificate compulsory). This class is out of competition and winners are not awarded by CAC nor compete for CACIB/BOB. Winners of honor class with "Excellent 1" compete in the finals in own competition.
- veteran class 8 years and over

Competitions:

- Child and the dog competition - Only for children from 3 to 9 years, The handling and presentation of the dog is evaluated, therefore the quality of the dog shown is not decisive. Competitors register for the competition in advance, but do not have to specify the dog with which they will participate in the competition. Child can also compete with a dog that was not judged at the given show, but always with a breed that is judged at the show on the given day. A child can only compete with one dog on one show day. The owner of the dog is responsible for damages caused by the dog.
- Best breeder's group – A breeder can enter his breeder's group of at least 3 and maximum 5 dogs or bitches of the same breed, color and size, which have been judged at this show. The dogs don't have to be owned by the breeder, but they must come from the same kennel from at least two different litters, at least two different sires and dams. A dog / bitch can only be entered to one breeder's group. Exhibitors are obliged to let their dogs compete in this competition when asked by the breeder.
- Best progeny group - Sire and minimum 5 descendants – judged at the show. The Sire must be not presented at the show.
- Best couple – an owner (100% same owners on both dogs) can enter his dog and bitch of the same breed and variety, that have been judged at this show.
- BIS minor puppy - Dogs and bitches awarded with „very promising 1“ in minor puppy class enter this competition
- BIS puppy - Dogs and bitches awarded with „very promising 1“ in puppy class enter this competition
- BIS honor class- Dogs and bitches awarded with „excellent 1“ in honor class enter this competition.
- BIS junior – Dogs awarded with title Best of Junior (BOJ) enter this competition.
- BIS veteran – Dogs awarded with title Best of veteran (BOV) enter this competition.
- BIS – Dogs awarded with title Best of Breed (BOB) enter this competition.

Prices:

Each shown dog will receive a certificate and a diploma. Class winners, breed winners, club show winners, competition winners, the best pair of dogs and the best breeding group will receive a material prize at the final competitions.

Application information and instructions:

Entry registration only via online system www.dogoffice.cz. Entry forms sent by post or email will not be accepted. The system always automatically confirms applications. The application is only valid if it has the status ACCEPTED. If it does not have it, the application is incomplete and needs to be completed. If you have not received the confirmation email, the registration has NOT PROCESSED! In such cases, contact us immediately at patou@email.cz. The organizer has the right not to admit a dog to the club show without giving a reason. By submitting the entry form, the exhibitor undertakes to comply with the rules and regulations of the FCI and ČMKU and the propositions of the club show. Registration of a dog in multiple classes, cancellation of registrations and registrations submitted after the deadline will not be accepted. Changing a class or cancel participation is possible until the deadline. The age of the dog on the day of the show (the day the dog is judged at the show) is decisive for inclusion in the class. To participate a dog in the winner class or honor class, the dog must have inserted scan in www.dogoffice.cz system one of these title: C.I.B., Champion title of some FCI country, National winner, Club winner, Winner of the special show, World winner or European winner (the title must be won in intermediate, open, working, winner or champion class) otherwise the dog will be entered to the open class.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

The acceptance of the dog to the club show will be confirmed approximately one week before the exhibition by an electronic entry confirmation, which will be sent to the exhibitors by e-mail. The exhibitor agrees to publish his name and address in the exhibition catalog and on the club's website.

Immediately at the show, check the correct classification of your dog/bitch in the class according to breed and sex. If a dog is not listed correctly in the catalog due to the organizer's fault, contact the show office immediately.

Documents for participation in the club show:

Pet passport, entry confirmation, pedigree.

General terms:

The club show is organized according to the Show Regulations of FCI and ČMKU and is open to dogs of breeds in this show regulation and registered in the studbooks recognized by the FCI or registered by a national FCI organization or an FCI partner organization. The age of the dog on the day of the show (on the day of judging the dog at the show) is decisive for inclusion in the class, other conditions must be met on the day of application. The organizer is not responsible for damages caused by the dog or exhibitor. The owner is responsible for all damage caused by his dog. Free running of dogs around the showground is prohibited. The organizer is not responsible for the death or loss of a dog during the show. Cropped and docked dogs (according to the Act on the Protection of Animals Against Cruelty nr. 246/1992, above all nr. 77/2004) and females in a higher stage of pregnancy, lactating females and individuals with an operative or other veterinary procedure to remove a defect in the dog's exterior are not allowed to enter the show ground. It is forbidden to adjust the coat, skin or muzzle of the dog with anything that changes their structure, color or shape. It is forbidden to groom the dog in the area of the show center with the help of any substances or aids. Only cutting, trimming, combing and brushing is allowed. It is also forbidden to tie the dog on the grooming table for a longer time than is necessary for grooming. Violation of this provision may result in the immediate exclusion of the dog from participation in the show. Exhibitors are obliged to comply with the provisions of the Exhibition Regulations of ČMKU and FCI, this show regulations and instructions of the show committee, to which they undertake by submitting an application. The exhibitor acknowledges that he is obliged to keep clean in the area of the showground. If the show is not held for reasons beyond the control of the organizer, the entry fees will be used to cover the incurred costs. Selling puppies at the exhibition grounds is strictly forbidden! During the exhibition, there will be a random check of the identity of the dogs (tattoo number/chip), according to the regulations of the ČMKU. The exhibitor is responsible for the well-being of his dog at the show – he must not expose him to situations that could endanger his health or even his life, e.g. leave it in the car in extreme winter or heat or treat it cruelly. Anyone who violates these principles will be excluded from this and subsequent shows. The exhibitor agrees to publish his name and address in the catalog and agrees to publish the results, photos and videos from the show.

Protest and other conditions:

Protest against the judge's decision – grade, placement, titles, etc., is not allowed. A protest can only be made for formal reasons (violation of show regulations or propositions), in writing, in the show office, at the time of the show until the judging in the ring is finished, along with the deposit of twice the exhibition fee for the 1st dog. The deposit will forfeit (in favor of the show organizer) in case the decision of the committee is negative.
